COUNCIL CAMPOREE

Brothers,

Once again, our lodge has been tasked by our council to support a council encampment. Scout Challenge 2019 is the council camporee that will be held March 22-24 at Bert Adams Scout Camp. We have been asked to conduct a "Patrol Challenge" event modeled after the OA Great Race that we conducted for the Council Centennial Campout100 in 2016. This time it will be called "Egwa Challenge" and it will have a smaller footprint and be conducted in a shorter competition timeframe than the OA Great Race. We will be conducting the Egwa Challenge from 9 AM to 4 PM Saturday on the backside of Camp Gorman in the general area of the rifle/shotgun ranges.

Our event planning committee has identified a need for approximately 100 Brothers to serve as game and support staff to allow us to successfully conduct this program. There is not a lodge fee for serving on the Egwa Challenge staff and there will be an Egwa Challenge staff t-shirt.

There are three options available for our Brothers willing to help staff "Egwa Challenge";

1. Register with your unit, pay participant fee, attend with unit for meals and housing, and serve on Egwa Challenge staff on Saturday.
2. Register with Scout Challenge 2019 as staff, pay staff fee, utilize staff housing and meals, and serve on Egwa Challenge staff on Saturday.
3. Pay no fee, show up Saturday morning, serve on Egwa Challenge staff, go home after breakdown/pack-up of event. (Bring your own lunch)

No matter which option you choose, you will need to register with the lodge as event staff at <http://www.aacegwa.org/register.htm> just follow the prompts and register as staff for Scout Challenge 2019, there is no fee to register, but it is essential that everyone register so we will know who is going to be staffing the event.
