The Honor Ceremonialist Award for Adults is intended to honor those Adult Advisers and Coaches to Ceremony teams who have served well as Advisers and Coaches, and have shown extraordinary service as an Adviser/Coach. This is intended to serve as a small token of the Lodge's gratitude toward our Advisers/Coaches, as they are incredibly important to the Order since they are the backbone behind the first impression candidates receive when entering the Order. This award can only be earned once per person in their lifetime. To be eligible for this award the following standards must be met within a 24-month period after January 1st 2015:

1. Assist in the setting up and execution of 7 ceremonies.
2. Coach/Advise a Ceremony Team for a total of 30 hours.
3. Know the basics of the Guide to Inductions and ensure they are followed to the best of your ability.*
