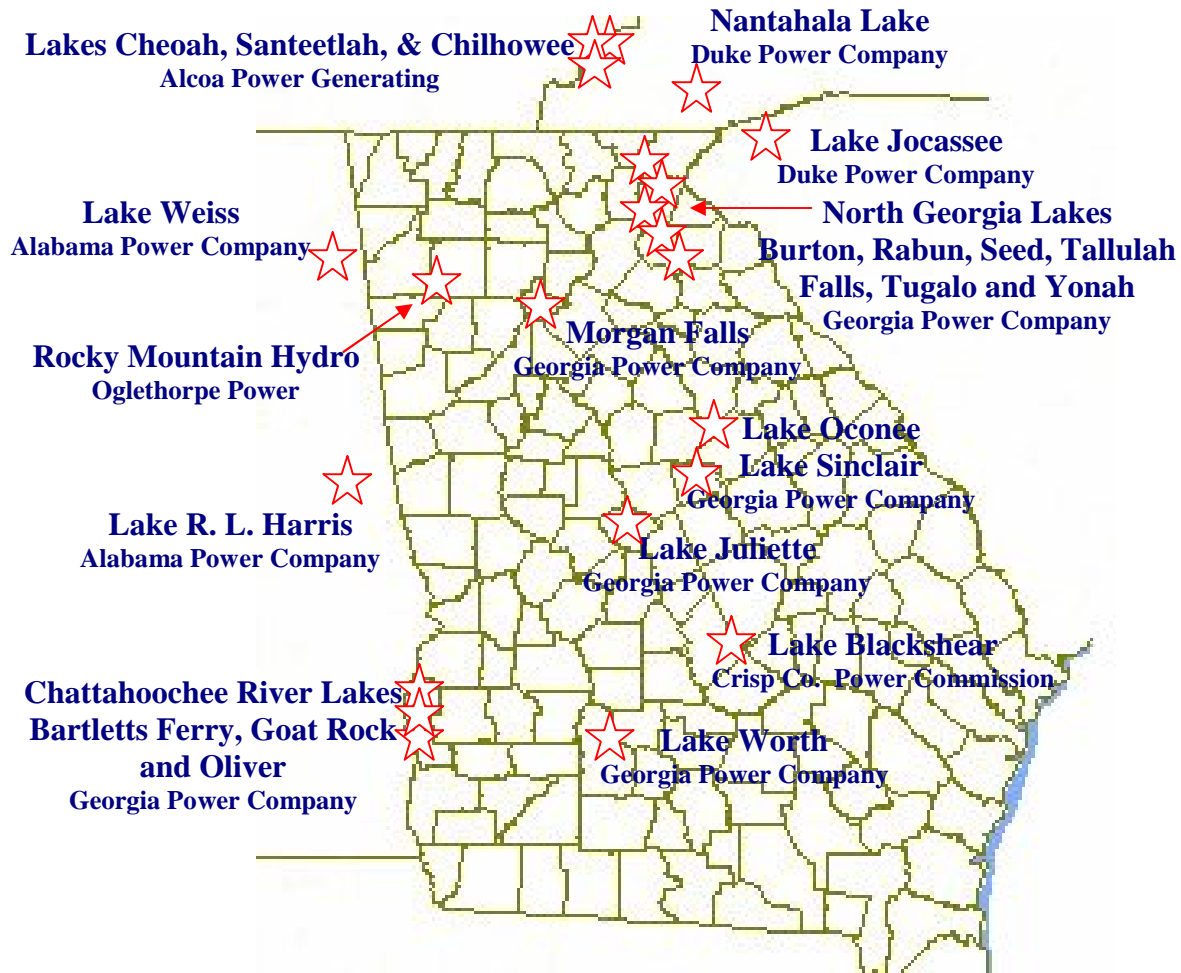


HYDROPOWER LAKES OPEN TO PUBLIC RECREATION USE IN AND NEAR GEORGIA

When a power company obtains a license* from the Federal Government to operate a hydropower project on public waterways, they are required to offer outdoor recreation access to project lands and waters. Most of these public facilities are in the form of boating access, but many of the power companies also offer camping and hiking trails at their lakes.
