- Announcements
 - Conclave- props and other theme related items have been ordered, t-shirts are on the way. Medical forms are required to participate in Conclave.
 - Ordeals- Ordeals are coming up, and more Elangomats are always needed. We will be using a new method with project Foremen to make the projects go smoother and quicker. They will be the experts on particular projects. The deadline to sign up for Woodruff Ordeal is April 20th. Ceremony teams need to contact Jeremy Lohr. Candidate registration is on-line.
 - SummitCorps- there are still a few spots available, registration is \$250 with transportation included. If finances are a problem, youth members should contact Ms. Parker about Egwa Fellow, our fundraiser and Egwa Fellow patches are in and now available.
 - Indian Summer- deadline is May 15th, there are open spots. Registration is \$315, and personal vehicles are mode of transportation.
