

BSA High Adventure Bases

Philmont Scout Reservation



Philmont Scout Ranch, located in Cimarron, New Mexico, is the BSA's oldest national high-adventure base. It covers 137,000 acres—about 214 square miles—of rugged mountain wilderness in the Sangre de Cristo (Blood of Christ) range of the Rocky Mountains in northern New Mexico. The ranch operates thirty-four staffed camps and 55 trail camps. Philmont has high mountains dominating rough terrain with elevations ranging from 6,500 to 12,441 feet. Backpacking treks, horseback cavalcades, training, and service opportunities are all offered at this one-of-a-kind adventure center. The dramatic scenery of New Mexico is home to world-class courses and seminars. Philmont Training Center is also located at the ranch. This is one of Scouting's premier training facilities. Philmont also offers the Double H High Adventure Camp at a separate location.

Arrowmen have the opportunity to participate in an OA Trail Crew. The first week of the Trail Crew is spent making Philmont a better place for others by building trails in the backcountry. The next week is spent experiencing Philmont at its finest, hiking a customized itinerary throughout the backcountry and participating in many of the activities offered at the camps along the way.

Sea Base

The Florida National High Adventure Sea Base is owned and operated by the National Council of the Boy Scouts of America to offer unique educational aquatic programs to our members. Located in Islamorada and on Summerland Key in the beautiful Florida Keys, as well as Marsh Harbour, Great Abaco Island, Bahamas, the heart of the Florida Keys, the near shore reefs and crystal clear waters offer unparalleled opportunities for long term and short term programs year round.

Florida Sea Base operates nine different adventures out of three different locations: two in the Florida Keys, and one in Marsh Harbour, Bahamas. Coral Reef Sailing, Sea Exploring Adventure, Scuba Adventure, Scuba Certification, and Live aboard Scuba Adventure operate in the Florida Keys at Mile Marker 73.8 at Sea Base on Lower Matecumbe Key located 75 miles south of Miami (Lower Matecumbe Key - MAP). Out Island Adventure and Keys Adventure programs operate in the Florida Keys on Summerland Key at Mile Marker 23.8, and at the Brinton Environmental Center located 125 miles south of Miami. Bahamas Adventure and Bahamas Tall Ship Adventures operate out of the Bahamas Sea Base in Marsh Harbour, Abaco, Bahamas, located about 100 miles east of Fort Lauderdale.
